Membership Expectations

The following are the reasonable expectations of members of our service club. It is our desire to disclose these to potential members as guidelines.

The sponsor of a potential member is expected to review these expectations and provide this executed document along with the membership application.

- Dues are \$150 per year, due October 1. The majority of these funds are sent to Kiwanis International.
- This club meets weekly for breakfast. Members are expected to attend **at least** two meetings per month when in town. A committee meeting, board meeting or other non-social club activity can contribute to this requirement, but attendance at breakfast meetings is the goal of this expectation.
- Members are encouraged to serve on one of the club's several committees.
- We are an apolitical organization.
- The Kiwanis Spaghetti Dinner, held on the last Saturday each February, is a major fundraiser for the club. All members are expected to make this a priority in their planning. This event is only successful with the full participation of **all** members.
- The *Diner's Delight* ticket books are the club's other major fundraiser. Our ability to provide grants to nonprofits and scholarships to deserving youth are only possible by the sale of all the limited number printed. Each member is encouraged to sell or purchase as many books as possible but is required to purchase or sell a minimum of five books.
- Members are encouraged to participate in other club-sponsored activities, such as event parking, luminary candle lighting and the Santa Run.

The Kiwanis Club of Sanibel-Captiva Islands has a nearly fifty-year history of service to island youth and the community in general, while striving to have as much fun doing it as is possible. We encourage all members to continue that tradition.
